SAC activities will overlap those of the adult meeting. Youth will attend the Saturday evening banquet and entertainment, and will lead the Saturday night worship service. Youth registration includes breakfast, lunch, snacks and dinner on Saturday, and breakfast on Sunday.

Housing and SAC activities will be at the historic UUSIC building, a fourblock walk from the Sheraton Hotel, the site of the PSD conference.

The youth registration fee is \$50. Each youth attendee must agree to follow the conference guidelines, and must have a sponsor from their congregation who is also attending the PSD conference. Sponsor responsibilities include attending the Friday night orientation session, maintaining contact with youth, and supporting youth during the weekend.
