Budget

Sally went over the budget that she submitted. Assumes least amount of revenue and highest expenses. \$1400 from Davenport has not been received, but that will go back out to White Bear UU. \$20 for children was initial reg cost, which does not cover their true expenses. Sally will work with Sara K and Sherry to make a youth budget. Profit is split 50/50 and PSD covers losses. Rooms are \$88 per night, so meals are more costly. Youth dinner on Saturday is \$30 per youth and is being absorbed by conference expense and not passed on to youth reg fee for Youth Con. Any youth who wants to attend the Ann Conference can pay the YA fee.

Sam – the estimates that Sally made with attendance by 200 and 300 adults looks good. Sarah G will take a good long look and let it be known if anything is out of line.

Home hospitality will be offered and DM is working on it. Discussion about recommending a donation to any home hospitality hosts. **Sally** will check with Sarah G about what this will look like on the website.

Sam said that Sarah G is more involved in the Ann Conf process and we send huge thanks to her thru Phil. Sarah Greene ROCKS!!!

We bless this budget and she will get it to Sarah for perusal.
